**WHAT**

Young Professionals are a musical theater-company under the 24/7 Student Repertory Company (24/7 SRC) umbrella, a 501 (c) (3), non-profit organization. 24/7 SRC is governed by a Board of Directors from Frederick and Washington Counties, all of whom have a passion for the arts. Young Professionals have a voting parent representative to the board and an executive director.

**WHY**

The purpose of the Young Professionals Repertory Company is to provide each student with a genuine respect for musical theater as an art form. We provide the opportunity to train with the best instructors from across the country, the opportunity to share their love of the arts with the community, and the resources to take their training to the next level.

**WHERE**

Young Professionals rehearsals are held in the 24/7 Dance Studio in Frederick, a venue that is ideal for serious training. The studio is conveniently located in the Weis Festival Shopping Center and boasts floating wood floors, video monitoring for parents, dressing room, vending area, and a Dance Boutique. Rehearsals are held on Friday nights or Saturday afternoons.

Rehearsals are held as follows:

Juniors (approx. 6-10)	1 hour/week
Teen (approx. 11-15)	1.5 hour/week
Senior (approx. 14+)	1.5 hours/week

Company Auditions will be held on Saturday, June 18, 2011 for all levels at 24/7 Dance Studio. Placement for the company is by audition only.

Be sure you are adequately warmed up for the audition and are dressed in clothing that will allow you to move.

The audition will consist of singing, dancing and acting.

1. Prepare a 1 minute monologue to perform
2. Prepare a 1 minute song to sing (bring your own music/sheet music)
3. Be prepared to learn a dance combination
4. Cold reading
